The Cumberland County Utilities Authority (CCUA) held it's Regular Monthly Meeting on Thursday, August 18, 2022, in the Meeting Room of the Operations Building, 333 Water Street, Bridgeton, New Jersey.

Chairman Jones called the meeting to order, announced that adequate notice of this meeting has been given in accordance with Chapter 231, P.L. (THE OPEN PUBLIC MEETING ACT) and Chairman Jones led the flag salute.

The new Commissioner, Ron Marino, was sworn in by counsel for the Cumberland County Utilities Authority, Kevin McCann

Secretary Maier called the roll, Commissioner Angelia Edwards and Commissioner William Andre' had excused absences. A quorum was present.

Vice Chairman Dawson called for a motion to amend the July 21, 2022, minutes by rescinding Resolution #3258, the motion was seconded by Commissioner Rajacich and approved.

Chairman Jones called for a motion to approve the minutes of the Regular Monthly Meeting of the July 21, 2022, with one exception, rescinding Resolution #3258. Moved by Vice Chairman Dawson and seconded by Commissioner Rajacich and approved.

Chairman Jones opened the floor for public comments on items on the agenda.

Mindy Piccioni from Hopewell Twp. asked what the reason was for rescinding Res. #3258. She was advised that the resolution was rescinded pending further legal review.

Mike Blaszczyk, President of CWA Local 1085, inquired about an employment matter. He was directed to take his inquiry to the administration through the grievance process. The Director advised there was no Executive Session scheduled at tonight's meeting.

Nancy Ridgeway from Upper Deerfield asked the Board to follow up on Mr. Blaszczyk's questions.

# Cumberland County Utilities Authority Authority Board Meeting Thursday August 18, 2022 Report of Executive Director

Mr. Chairman, Commissioners, Staff, and members of the Public: I would like to begin by submitting the Discharge Monitoring Report (DMR) for May 2022 for inclusion into the minutes of this report.

#### **Activities for the Month:**

 I would like to start by welcoming our new Commissioner Ron Marino and I look forward to working with you moving forward. Additionally, I would like to thank everyone for taking the time to attend today's Board Meeting.

## • Budget & Finance

- The Authority continues to work with the Auditor on the 2021 audit.
- The Authority is starting preparation for the 2023 Budget.
- **Sludge Disposal** The Authority is currently hauling two (2) loads per day to Delcora with C&H providing assistance as needed. The sludge storage tank is at an acceptable level at this time.
- **Plant Discharge** The plant is operating well, and we are meeting our effluent discharge limits, in some cases we are meeting those limits in the single digits.

#### Operations and Maintenance –

- The head structure upgrade project has continued this month. The temporary piping modifications was completed, and the grit system was placed back in-service on August 5 th, 2022. The observed flow was reported back to the manufacturer Hydro International, and a new vortex valve will be designed, fabricated, and installed when delivered. The new grit system is currently in operation with no other additional issues being observed.
- On August 3rd, 2022, operations placed the upgraded Hydrodyne bar screen online with no problems reported at this time.
- On August 2nd, 2022, management staff met with representatives from SHI and Schneider Electric to discuss the status of the planned SCADA upgrade as well as a pump station walk through.
- Beginning on August 1st, 2022, the Authority conducted its required semiannual bioassay analysis.

- Management staff met virtually with representatives from the NJDEP to discuss the Authority's future PFAS sampling and reporting requirements.
- On July 25th, 2022, Garrison Enterprises started the repair of the damaged force main from the septage receiving station. The work has been completed with no problems being reported at this time
- **Collection System** The Authority is waiting for preliminary designs for Glass Street Pump Station upgrades / rehabilitation.

#### Miscellaneous –

- The Authority sent out sludge samples for analysis for the sludge processing master plan and are awaiting results. CES is awaiting these test results before proceeding with the biosolids master plan evaluation.
- On August 11th, 2022, the Authority held its bid opening for the installation of the new pumps at Glass Street Pump Station, award resolution is on tonight's agenda.
- On August 16th, 2022, the Authority held its bid opening for outside laboratory services, rejection/readvertise resolution for non-conformance is on tonight's agenda.

#### Engineer

Bob Serpente was present and reported that sludge samples have been sent out to four manufacturers and we are awaiting the results. We should have some results hopefully next month.

# A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CUMBERLAND COUNTY UTILITIES AUTHORITY TO RENEW ITS MEMBERSHIP IN THE CUMBERLAND COUNTY INSURANCE COMMISSION

WHEREAS, on September 25, 2012, the Board of Chosen Commissioners of the County of Cumberland (the "County") established a County Insurance Commission for the purposes provided by law; and

WHEREAS, the existence of the Cumberland County Insurance Commission is intended to provide Cumberland County's various boards, agencies, authorities and commissions with the opportunity to combine resources to manage their liability and casualty risks and employee health insurance, as may be authorized; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:10:8 et seq. the County of Cumberland appointed three County officials to serve as Commissioners of the County Insurance Commission; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the rules and regulations adopted by the Cumberland County Insurance Commission, the commissioners shall be officials of the County of Cumberland and are authorized to perform all the duties as set forth in N.J.S.A 40A:10-10 and all applicable rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the various County boards, agencies, authorities and commissions shall have representation on the safety committee and the advisory committee established by the Cumberland County Insurance Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Cumberland County Utilities Authority (hereinafter "Governing Body") has determined it is in the best interest of the Authority for the Governing Body to renew its membership in the Cumberland County Insurance Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, membership in the Cumberland County Insurance Commission shall be for a period not to exceed three (3) years; now, therefore,

### **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Cumberland County Utilities Authority's Board as follows:

- Section 1. The Governing Body hereby accepts the finding that participation in the Cumberland County Insurance Commission will continue to result in cost savings and administrative efficiencies in the management of its liability and casualty risks.
- Section 2. The Governing Body agrees to renew its membership in the Cumberland County Insurance Commission.
- Section 3. The Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to publish and/or file any notices that may be required by applicable law.
- Section 4. The Director or his designee is hereby authorized to execute any agreement, including an indemnity and trust agreement, or other documents required by the Cumberland County Insurance Commission to affect the purposes of this Resolution.

## RESOLUTION OF THE CUMBERLAND COUNTY UTILITIES AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING A PURCHASING AGENT TO CERTIFY FUNDS

WHEREAS, P.L. 2009, c. 166, codified as N.J.S.A. 40A:11-2 et seq., supplementing and amending Chapter 11 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes allows local contracting units in New Jersey to create the position of Purchasing Agent; and

WHEREAS, the Cumberland County Utilities Authority appointed Dominic Buirch as Purchasing Agent; and

WHEREAS, the Cumberland County Utilities Authority hereby authorizes the Purchasing Agent to certify funds and make all other necessary transactions in order to effectuate the duties of Purchasing Agent.
